- If the student's home university is located in onw of these countries: Botswana, Brazil, China, Ghana, Latvia, Lithuania, Malaysia, Mosambique, Nigeria, Senegal, Swaziland, Republic of Korea, Russia, Thailand or Vietnam.
- If the student's nationality can be found in this list which is available at www.tuas.fi/informationpackage

The documents have to be provided by the home country. The documents must be in English.

- Doctor's Statement of Health
- Health Statement by Physician: the Result of Thorax X-ray

The Health Documents required of students coming to study at Turku University of Applied Sciences will be collected in the beginning of the semester / practical training by the Health Nurse or the International Coordinator.

About the health insurance:

To achieve the residence permit to Finland, your insurance must cover medical expenses in the amount of 100,000 euros. You must have insurance for your entire stay in Finland. Your insurance must be valid at the time of your arrival in Finland.

If you fall ill the expenses can easily be thousands of euros.
